ABOUT THE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT CORPORATION (CIC)

In March 2024, the Granville Area Chamber of Commerce (GACC), Granville Exempted Village School District (GEVSD), and the Village of Granville executed a Memorandum of Understanding to collectively establish a Community Improvement Corporation (CIC) in an effort to proactively and positively influence economic development endeavors in the Greater Granville Area (defined as the boundary of the GEVSD).

CICs were established by the State of Ohio General Assembly in 1961 under Senate Bill 299 and are currently defined under the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 1724. Put simply, a CIC is non-profit economic development corporation created for the following purposes: *advancing, encouraging, and promoting the industrial, economic, commercial, and civic development of a community.*

The CIC Board will be comprised of at least three board members. Each of three incorporating entities will appoint their respective representive to the board. The CIC Board will be a working board with the power to appoint two additional at-large members as needed. Please note this is a volunteer position and there is no compensation for CIC Board Members.

QUALIFICATIONS & EXPECTATIONS

The board of directors is the governing body of the Greater Granville Area Community Improvement Corporation (CIC). Its members represent a cross-section of the business and professional leadership of the community. It is considered an honor to serve on the board, and genuine unselfish interest in the Greater Granville Area CIC and its objectives is the first requirement of the board member.

A willingness to spend the time and effort necessary to give proper attention to CIC objectives.

Ability to work constructively and harmoniously with other board members, staff, and community leaders in accordance with policies established by the board. A business background coupled with work experience that enables exercising sound judgment in considering resolution to problems as related to overall economic development objectives.

Courage and ability to have an objective opinion and willingness to face community problems even though the issues may be controversial.

Ability to lead and inspire others to execute worthwhile initiatives supported by the CIC and to motivate others to help with community problems facing area businesses.

Demonstrated ability and record of effective community service.

Able/willing to commit to a 5+ hours/week (or equivalent) to CIC matters.

Desired attributes: open-mindedness, insightful, relationship-builder mindset.

Desired experience: knowledge of public financing options, familiarity with commercial real estate, planning and development background and/or experience with planning and zoning, understanding of state and local economic development programs, funding sources, and policies.
